CONFERENCE DETAILS

The conference theme is *Peacemaking Through Truth and Reconciliation*.

The core conference events take place 12th-14th August 2026, with additional optional activities available 15th-16th August.

The content includes thoughtful panel sessions, round-tables, participatory workshops, and an “Ideas Fair”. It also includes an evening with 21-year-old Autumn Peltier (an indigenous rights activist).

Conference sessions will be conducted in English French and Spanish.

Participants will be treated to insights into diverse aspects of Canadian nature, life and cultures. Additional optional activities include an “Indigenous cultural experience” and a spectacular “immersive” Arctic experience with underwater viewing tunnels (polar bears!) Optional activities and excursions are open to travelling companions, too.

Excursions include:

- the National Indian Residential School Museum, which “preserves the history and experiences of survivors to foster healing and understanding”
- the Winnipeg art scene,
- and a sculpture garden, with opportunities to sample First Nations cuisine.

Add to that, opportunities for networking, sharing, and informally listening and learning from each other, and the conference is unmissable for everyone engaged in, or simply curious about, museums for peace. That means you!
