The Advisory Committee may provide input to the General Coordinator and Executive Board on issues that are relevant to the functioning of the Network.

* Additional Guidelines for Nominations & Elections:

- Individual members may self-nominate for either Executive Board or Advisory Council, not both.
- Although there may be up to 4 email addresses on the INMP mailing list under an Institutional/Organizational membership, only one individual may self-nominate for a seat on the Executive Board or Advisory Council. If more than one individual in an institutional membership wishes to run for office, then the second person must register and re-enrol as an Individual Member.
- In the Election, only one individual in an Institutional INMP membership may vote. (As with nominations, the second individual in an Institutional Membership must register and re-enrol as an Individual Member to be allowed to vote.)
